

BAU took place from January 16 to 21, 2017 at Munich Trade Fair Center

2,120 exhibitors from 45 countries gave the fair top marks

ESWA members presented a broad spectrum of new products in roofing and waterproofing

On 183,000 m² of exhibition space, BAU was presenting a display of architecture, materials and systems for commercial and residential construction, for both new - build and renovation projects. The show filled up again all the available halls at the exhibition center. Here around 2,120 exhibitors from approximately 45 countries were showcasing a comprehensive range of materials and technologies for planning and construction. 250,000 visitors from which 80,000 were from abroad viewed in more detail all the technologies, products and materials that are used in building, renovation and modernization. Architectural solutions, materials and systems for commercial and residential construction and for interior fit were presented.

The many attractive events in the supporting program, including high - caliber forums with experts from all over the world, rounded off this industry showcase.

Reinhard Pfeiffer, the Managing Director responsible for the fair, is pleased with the results: "Once again, BAU has set a number of new records. In doing so, it has done an impressive job of demonstrating its position as a driving force behind innovation and a source of momentum to the construction industry."

Interested visitors could be found on ESWA members' exhibition stands represented in two different halls. Videos of welding techniques and modern laying processes informed the roofers and sustainable roofing membranes with a long life cycle impressed visitors.

Sustainability and individual material options are ever more noticeable in the portfolios of the ESWA manufacturers. In terms of quality, safety and applications thermoplastic roofing membranes register increasing popularity amongst the users.

The next BAU will feature two new halls when it takes place at the Messe München trade fair center from January 14 to 19, 2019. The trade-fair center will then have 200,000 square meters of exhibition space.
